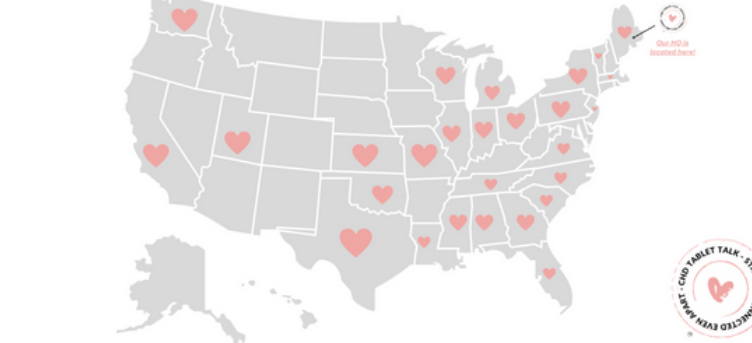
OUR WORK

LOVE FOR LITTLES

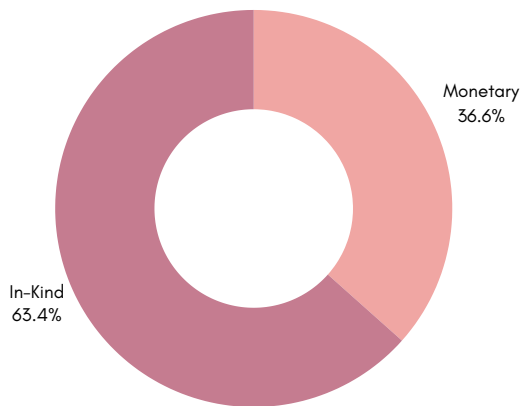

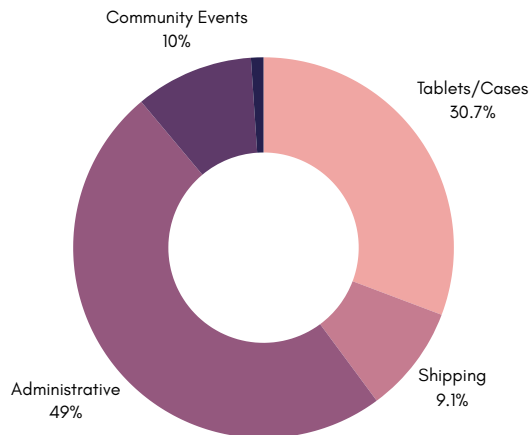
